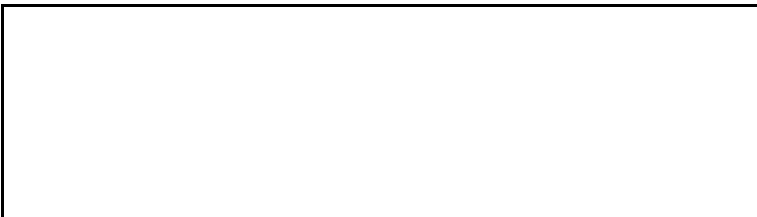

Dear Members,

It is time to renew our contract with the Elks Lodge for January to December 2017. They have offered 2 very fair options for our luncheons. We will vote on which one to choose at our first meeting of 2017. Please read this carefully and come out to vote at the January business meeting.

**Option I -**
